# City Beach Residential College

*Nurture the gift and extend the talent*

Modern buildings set in a quiet and safe bush setting next to Reabold Park, 15 minutes drive to Subiaco and just 10 minutes walk to City Beach.

The college comprises five blocks of two storey townhouses all of which have views over bushland and the city.

Male and female students live in separate blocks with staff nearby. Each townhouse contains six bedrooms, three bathrooms, a well equipped kitchen and a dining/lounge room.

Students enjoy the use of a full-size school gymnasium, football oval, courts for tennis, basketball, netball and beach volleyball, as well as swings, slides and exercise bars.

School days begin with breakfast, but the pace quickens as students get themselves and their bedrooms clean and tidy before heading off to school.

Public transport and college buses provide for student travel needs to and from school and give them ready access to many recreational options and venues on weekends.

After school the students change out of their school uniforms before joining in a range of recreational activities. Dinner is followed by a quiet study time before supper and bed time.

Weekends are more relaxed – and hectic! Wake up and bed times are more flexible, but the days can be full of activities like sport, excursions, shopping and socials.

The City Beach Residential College is operated by the Country High School Hostels Authority and parents can be assured of the highest standard of care and supervision.

Experienced and qualified staff in nine residential colleges throughout the State receive high approval ratings from parents for the care and service they provide.
