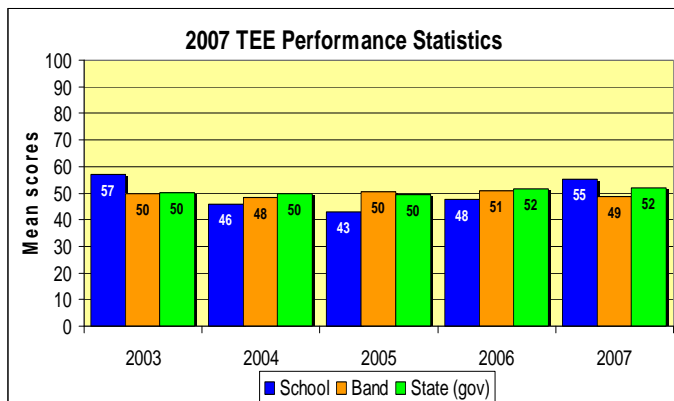

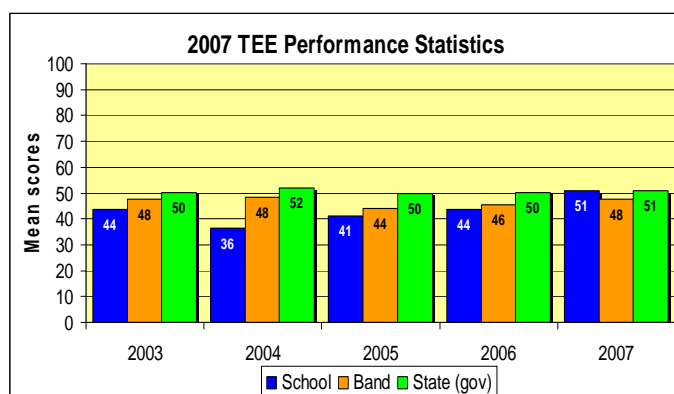


Overall sound results with student performance above both the state and the band. Students were coached not to attempt questions that referred to specific images. History & Analysis continues to be the area of most concern with students not submitting assessments or taking the opportunity to attend after hour tutorials.

2008 Goals - Students will be exposed to 'Perspectives' exhibit 2008 and able to access visual diary tutorial. After school / holiday / lunchtime access for students to continue. Close investigation on question

choice in exams and lessons / tutorials to address this. More work on unseen image analysis focussing on the history of the movements rather than the visual analysis. Greater emphasis on the importance of performance in written exam.

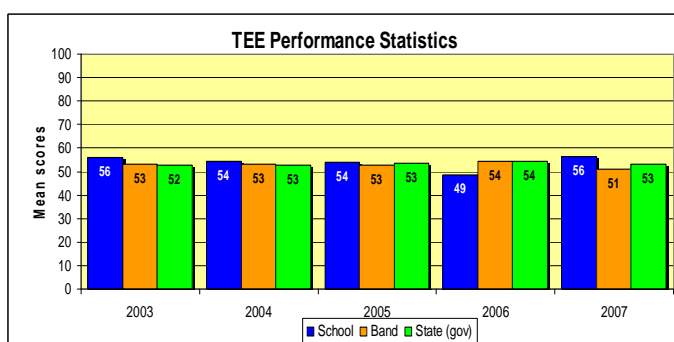
Drama Studies



The school was almost on a par with the state, and performed above the band. The teacher, a graduate, was a little too rigorous in assessment as the model indicated. However, in comparison with past years, there was a significant improvement in the standard achieved by students.

2008 Goals - Work with Curriculum Council personnel to develop skills in accurate assessment. Continue with small group moderation partnerships.

ENGLISH



In 2007 the 51 students from Hampton who sat the final WACE exam achieved above the State average. This is an excellent result and we will continue the same processes in 2008. These processes include common assessment tasks and a focus on exam technique. Our reference to the SSASS good answers book, co-authored by Will Bronleigh continues to be a useful guide.

2008 Goals - Students will have practice in the use of genres other than essays.
